Primary Performance Measures

2017 Headline Measures are due to appear in December 2017.

This setting is Alternative Provision, and so Floor Standards do not apply.

There are typically fewer than 11 KS2 outcomes, so summary statistics have very wide confidence intervals.

For 2017, there were two pupils, making the calculation of summary measures inappropriate.

The following estimates indicate the interval in which we would expect the measures to lie.

These approximations are based on the attainment of current KS2 pupils

Percentage who achieved expected standard in Reading, Writing and Maths	25% to 35%
Average Scaled Score in READING	88 to 98
Average Scaled Score in MATHS	90 to 100
Percentage achieving a higher standard in Reading, Writing and Maths	0% to 10%
Average Progress in READING	Unable to estimate at present, but other evidence suggests average progress is as expected.
Average Progress in WRITING	Unable to estimate at present, but other evidence suggests average progress is below expected.
Average Progress in MATHS	Unable to estimate at present, but other evidence suggests average progress is below expected.
